4 Wall, 32 Count, Easy Intermediate Cha Cha

Music: Big House, Amarillo, 100 BPM**

Big House, Love Ain't Easy, 104 BPM

Teaching: Vince Gill, I Can't Tell You Why, Common Threads CD, 84 BPM

CROSS ROCK, RECOVER, CHA, BACK ROCK, RECOVER, CHA

1-2 Cross rock L over R, recover on R

3&4 Cha Cha LRL in place

5-6 Cross rock R behind L, recover on L

7&8 Cha Cha RLR in place

FWD ROCKS, 1/2 TURN SHUFFLE, SHUFFLE FWD

9 Rock forward on L lifting R slightly

10 Recover back onto R lifting L slightly

11 Rock forward on L lifting R slightly

12 Recover back onto R lifting L slightly

13&14 Turn 1/2 left on ball of R and shuffle forward LRL

15&16 Shuffle forward RLR

VINE, 1/4 TURN SHUFFLE, ROCK BACK, RECOVER, CHA IN PLACE

17-18 Step L to left side, cross step R behind L

19&20 Shuffle LRL in place turning 1/4 left

21 Rock back on R behind L lifting L slightly

22 Rock forward onto L lifting R slightly

23&24 Shuffle in place RLR

KICK, CROSS, SIDE SHUFFLE, SHUFFLE BEHIND, SIDE SHUFFLE

25-26 Kick L forward, cross step L over R

27&28 Step R to right as you shuffle RLR to right side

29&30 Cross shuffle LRL behind R moving to right side

31&32 Step R to right as you shuffle RLR to right side

Begin again.

*Note: Amarillo by Big House has a very "blues" feeling to it, hence the name...
But the dance should work for any slow to medium cha cha.*
