32 Count, 4 Wall, 32 Count Intermediate Line Dance

Music: Bon Temps Roulette, Corbin Hanner Band,123 bpm, By Request CD, 16 intro

Other: Ten Rounds With Jose Cuervo, Tracy Byrd,127 bpm, Ten Rounds CD

Teach: Feels Like Love, Vince Gill 100 bpm, Let's Make Sure We Kiss Goodbye CD

SIDE, BEHIND, TRIPLE IN PLACE x2

1-2 Step R to right, cross step L behind R

3&4 Triple in place RLR

5-6 Step L to left, cross step R behind L

7&8 Triple in place LRL

FWD WALKS, KICK-BALL-CHANGE, FWD ROCK, RECOVER, FULL BACK TURN

9-10 Walk forward R, L

11&12 Kick R forward, step on ball of R next to L, step L next to R

13-14 Rock forward onto R, recover weight on L

15 Making 1/2 turn right step forward on R

16 Making 1/2 turn right step back on L

Note: Steps 15 and 16 make a full turn to the back

Easier Option on 15-16: Walk back R, walk back L

1/4 SHUFFLE, CROSS ROCK, RECOVER, 1/4 TURN, 1/2 TURN, BACK COASTER

17&18 Turn 1/4 right shuffling RLR

19-20 Cross rock L over R, recover weight to R

21 Turn 1/4 left stepping forward on L

22 Turn 1/2 left, stepping back on R

23&24 Step back on L, step R next to L, step forward on L

STEP, HOLD, BALL-STEP, STEP, 1/2 PIVOT, 1/4 PIVOT

25-26 Step forward on R, hold

&27-28 Step ball of L by R heel, step forward R, step forward L

29-30 Step forward on R, pivot 1/2 left, weight ending on L

31&32 Step forward on R, pivot 1/4 left, weight ending on L

Begin again.

Optional Ending: After 12th pattern facing 12:00:

Repeat counts 1 – 8 of dance. Then do a R kick ball change, cross R over L and do a full turn unwind over the next 4 counts as the music fades out. OR...just dance it out.

It will end on the kickball change and forward rock count 13.....

Note 1: I had originally put in an 8 count tag to be done at the end of the chorus but found it worked just as well without one.... so enjoy! No tags!

Note 2: I found the original version of this song in a used music store a couple years ago. I fell in love with this song and talked to the artists about doing a line dance for the song and asked if they could put it on a new album. At that time their old recording company held the rights to it. It is now available on **their new CD By Request available at www.corbinhanner.com**. They are songwriters who have their own band and perform around Pennsylvania. Many artists have recorded their

music. A song of theirs, "She Rides Wild Horses", was recently recorded by Kenny Rogers on his CD of the same name.
