32 count, 4 Wall, Easy Intermediate Line Dance

Music: I Can't Stay Long, Jason Sellers, 156 bpm, CD: I'm Your Man, 16 intro

Music is straight rhythm with a schottische flavor....

1/4 TURN JAZZ WITH SCUFF, 1/2 TURN JAZZ WITH SCUFF

- 1-2 Cross step L over R, step R straight back
- 3-4 Turn 1/4 left stepping L to left side, scuff R across L (9:00)
- 5-6 Cross step R over L, turn 1/4 right stepping L back (12:00)
- 7--8 Turn 1/4 right stepping R to right side, scuff L across R (3:00)

CROSS, BACK, WEAVE, 1/4 TURN, FWD

- 9-10 Cross step L over R, step R straight back
- 11-12 Step L to left, cross step R over L
- 13-14 Step L to left, cross step R behind L
- 15-16 Turn 1/4 left stepping L forward, step forward R (12:00)

FWD, HOLD, FWD ROCK, RECOVER, BACK, HOOK, FWD, SCUFF

- 17-18 Step forward on L, hold
- 19-20 Rock forward on R, recover on L
- 21-22 Step back on R, hook L foot over R leg
- 23-24 Step forward on L, scuff R forward

SLOW 1/2 PIVOT, FWD, 1/2 TURN, 1/4 TURN, HOLD

- 25-26 Step forward on R, hold
- 27-28 Pivot 1/2 left weight ending on L, hold (6:00)
- 29-30 Step forward R, turn 1/2 right stepping back on L (12:00)
- 31-32 Turn 1/4 right stepping R to right side, hold (3:00)

Begin Again

One Tag: At end of 1st pattern (3:00) - add these 8 counts (SIDE MAMBOS):

- 1-4 Rock left on L, recover on R, step L beside R, hold
- 5-8 Rock right on R, recover on L, step R beside L, hold

Ending: Music fades out near the end of the 12th pattern. Dance through count 14. Then step L to left without the 1/4 turn and hold. Finish facing front wall.

Note: At end of each pattern on count 16 you should be facing 12:00. It will help to keep you on track with the turns if you let your body do the turns but keep you keep looking at the 12:00 wall as you dance the first 16 counts.

Note: During pattern 8 the music restarts (dropping the last 4 counts) but the beat continues. Just keep dancing the pattern to the end. It doesn't need a restart.
