

EASY DOES IT32 Count Version of John's Dance

32 Count, 2 Wall, Easy Intermediate Line Dance

Music: If You Ain't Lovin', George Strait, 156 BPM, Ten Strait Hits CD

I'm Gone, Mark Chesnutt, 150 BPM, I Don't Want To Miss A Thing CD

Faster: Peace Of Mind, George Strait, 170 BPM, Always Never The Same CD,
or similar two-step type music

Teach: Down Louisiana Way, George Strait, 128 BPM, Lead On CD

FWD 1/2 TURNS, FWD-SLIDE-FWD, TOUCH

1-2 Step forward on R, pivot 1/2 turn right on ball of R while hooking L behind R leg

3-4 Step back on L, pivot 1/2 turn right on ball of L while hooking R in front of L leg

Easier Option: 1-4: Step forward R, scuff L forward, step forward L, scuff R forward

5-6 Step forward R, slide L to R putting weight on it

7.8 Step forward R, touch L toe slightly behind R

BACK, HITCH, BACK HITCH, BACK-SLIDE-BACK, SCUFF

9-10 Step back on L, hitch R knee

11-12 Step back on R, hitch L knee

13-14 Step back L, slide R to L putting weight on it

15-16 Step back L, scuff R forward

1/4 TURN JAZZ BOX, FWD, HOLD, SHUFFLE FWD

17-18 Cross step R over L, step back on L

19-20 Step R to right turning 1/4 right, step L next to R

21-22 Step forward R, hold

23-24 Shuffle forward LRL

STEP, HOLD, KICK BALL CHANGE, WALK BACK, 1/4 TURN COASTER

25-26 Step slightly forward R, hold,

27&28 Kick L forward, step ball of L next to R, step R in place

29-30 Step back L, R

31&32 Step back L turning 1/4 right, step R next to L, step forward L

Begin again

Note: I was asked to choreograph this dance by Sue Hardy for her husband John who very recently passed away. John was a country line dance instructor in the UK. They both taught and danced from almost the inception of country line and couples dancing in England. I met them about 7 years ago when they visited Cactus Moon in Tucson. John was a very special person. He always looked for the best in everyone. I count him as one of my very wonderful friends. It was requested that this dance be to a George Strait song and be happy and fun because that's the way he always was. I always remember him with a smile on his face....He is missed.
